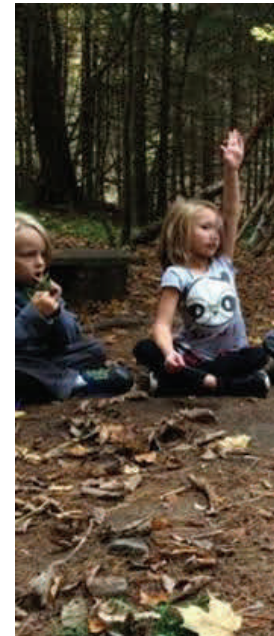
## Summer Camps 2017

## ALL THE BASICS

- Camps cost \$40 - \$50 per day or \$200 - \$250 per week on a sliding scale.
- Enclose one week's payment with your registration.
- Full payment for each week is due at the beginning of that week.
- We accept Vermont childcare subsidies.
- Camps are for children entering grades 1—5 next year.
- We need a current registration/medical form for your child. The registration form is online at [www.communityconnections.us](http://www.communityconnections.us)
- Camp hours are 8:00 AM—5:30 PM
- **After 5:30, there is a \$15 late fee for every 15 min.!!!**
- We will provide healthy snacks; you provide lunch.
- Transportation and admission fees are included.
- CC field trips are money-free activities. We will not go to gift shops, vending machines, arcades, etc.
- Please let us know how we may best help your child enjoy camp and discuss any special needs that your child may have.
- Personal audio, phones, and video games are allowed at your own risk, and only on the bus.
- **All camps will need a minimum of 15 children registered by June 1st in order to run. A full refund will be given in the event of cancellation.**

### PACKING LIST

- Lunch—we will provide snacks and milk
- Send appropriate clothing/items: swim suit, towel, sunscreen, bug spray, sneakers, outdoor gear, dry socks, rain jacket, boots, etc.
- Send a water bottle.
